How to Tie a Panopto In-Video Quiz to Your Canvas Gradebook For Teaching Teams

- **To tie your in-video quiz results to the Canvas gradebook you must have already created the in-video quiz in your video lecture. For instructions on how to add in-video quizzing to your lecture video, please contact panoptohelp@Stanford.edu for any assistance.**

You'll start by creating an assignment in your Canvas course page.

1. Select the **Assignments** Tab
2. Click on the blue **+Assignment** button



